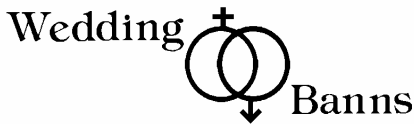

NEW FAMILY/FIRST TIME RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

If your child is entering the Religious Education Program, a form needs to be completed. You are most welcome to drop by the office during normal business hours (or by scheduling a mutually-convenient appointment.) Please bring a copy of the child’s Baptismal Certificate (if not celebrated at Saint Pius V). We have found that on-site “first-time” registration is a great service to our parish family.

The First Reconciliation/First Eucharist Program is a two-year program (inclusive of Grade One). If your child has not completed Grade One Program, we offer the “Rite of Christian Initiation Program (adapted for children). Please call the office if you have a question regarding this or any other program.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN RELIGIOUS EDUCATION is available only on Sunday mornings from 10:00-11:10 AM. Children who are four may attend, even though they may not be attending Pre-Kindergarten in a public school. There is no tuition for “Pre-K”. If you have *any questions* regarding your child’s “eligibility”, please contact the Office of Religious Education.
