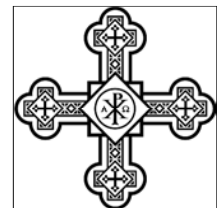

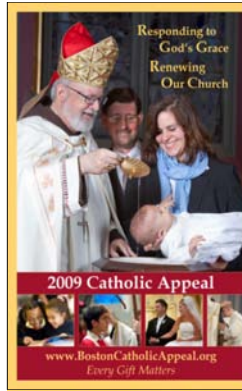


Operation Troop Support

Daily Mass Schedule: The 9:00 a.m. morning Mass is at Saint Margaret Church on Mondays, Tuesdays & Wednesdays and at Blessed Sacrament Church on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays.

Saint Margaret Parish Religious Education: Registration forms for enrollment in our Parish Religious Education Program were mailed last week to all those enrolled in the past year. Parents of those entering the First Grade, students new to the Parish and 10th Graders enrolled in Catholic High Schools should pick up registrations forms at the Rectory. Included with the registrations forms is a schedule of classes for 2009-2010. Classes for Grades 1 through 6 are held on Sunday morning from 8:30 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. at the Belmonte Middle School. Grades 7 & 8 are held on Friday evenings once a month at Saint Margaret Parish Hall. Year I Confirmation (usually Grade 9 but older students are welcome) (Students who attend Catholic High Schools need not attend Year I) classes are Sunday afternoons from 4:30 to 5:45 p.m. Confirmation Year II is held once a month as per the schedule and is for all those who are to be Confirmed in the spring of 2010. All those enrolled in Catholic High Schools must attend also. (Catholic High School do not prepare their Students for Confirmation. That is the Parish's responsibility.) The registration fee remains the same as last year.

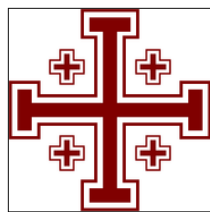

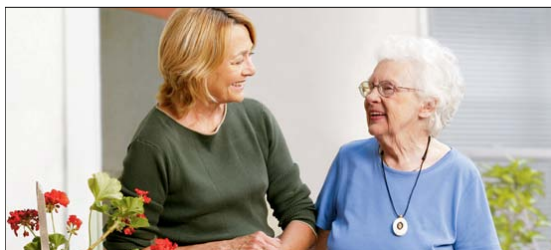


The National Shrine of Divine Mercy, Stockbridge, MA:

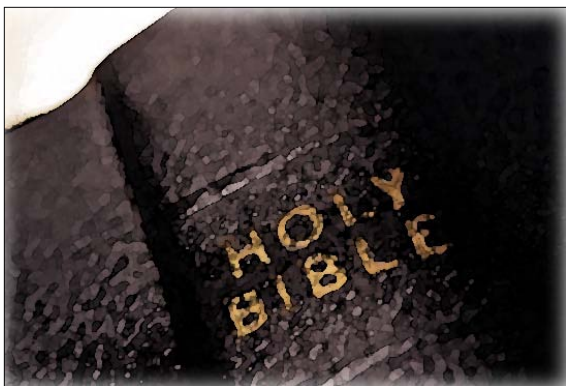

Introduction to the Bible

The Bible holds a unique and cherished place within the life of the Church, as witnessed to by the 2nd Vatican Council:

“In the sacred books, the Father, who is in heaven, comes lovingly to meet His children and talks with them. And such is the force and power in the word of God

that it is the Church’s support and strength, imparting robustness to the faith of its daughters and sons and providing food for their souls.” (Dei Verbum, 21)

St. Jerome, a 5th century Father and Doctor of the Church, went so far as to say:

“Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ.”

While the Bible is God’s living voice speaking to the Church, it is also a complex book (or, collection of books) that, quite honestly, can be daunting to read. Where should one begin? Well, this course might be an excellent starting point. Topics to be covered include:

- The Jewish roots of Christianity
- How the Bible came to be written
- The Bible as *our* faith story
- The languages and literature of the Bible
- The God of the Bible
- Interpreting the Bible, according to the Church
- Praying with the Bible

When? The course will meet every Saturday in August from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m., beginning on August 1st.

Where? For the first four weeks, the course will meet in the parish hall at Blessed Sacrament. The final meeting, on August 29th, will be held in the parish hall at St. Margaret’s.

Instructor: Steve Dalton

Steve holds a masters degree in Religious Studies, with a concentration in Sacred Scripture, from Providence College. A parishioner at St. Margaret’s, Steve once taught with the Word of God Ministry and has extensive experience offering Bible study courses to adult Catholics. He has been married to his wife Marianne for 27 years. They have three children and are currently expecting their fourth grandchild.
