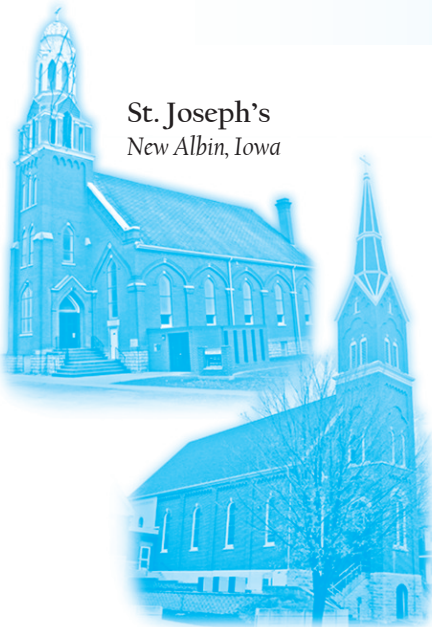

Question: I have heard that some Bishops have told the parishes in their diocese to offer Communion only under the species of bread and not wine because of the swine flu and other diseases. Do the people then receive only half of Jesus?

Answer: It has always been held from the earliest days of the Church that if a person receives Communion under one species they receive the total Jesus. The reception of Communion under both species is a practice begun in the Catholic Church about 20 years ago. Before that time (as many of you know) only the bread was offered and yet the totality of Jesus was received and so it is today. I know that our Archbishop Hanus has been approached by some noted health care providers to ask parishes not to offer the species of wine in the Archdiocese and so far Archbishop Hanus has not acted. He might make a decision like other bishops if the flu becomes more serious-it is his call.

Call Fr. Knipper if you are going into the hospital or have the hospital staff call Father if you are in the hospital.

Sen. Tom Coburn commented to Supreme Court nominee Sonia Sotomayor his following statement: "We now record heartbeat 14 days post-conception. We record fetal brainwave at 39 days post-conception. And I don't expect you to comment on this but I do expect you to pay attention to it as you contemplate these big issues. We have this schizophrenic rule of law where we have defined death as the absence of those but we refuse to define life as the presence of those." Sonia did not comment! Too bad that Sonia as a professed Catholic and especially as a professed human being is not willing to protect life from the moment of conception.
