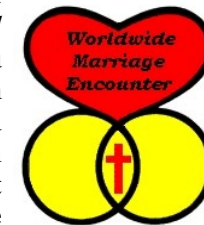

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

If Jesus Christ were on earth today, how would he spread his message of salvation? Would he use television, radio, magazines, newspapers, text messages, billboards, DVDs, or would Jesus be right here on the Internet?
