### Why is it called the "Lord's Prayer"?

"The *Our Father* is called the "Oratio Dominica," that is, the Lord's Prayer because it was taught to us by the Lord Jesus himself. It is the prayer of the Church *par excellence*. It is "handed on" in Baptism to signify the new birth of the children of God into the divine life. The full meaning of the *Our Father* is revealed in the Eucharist since its petitions are based on the mystery of salvation already accomplished, petitions that will be fully heard at the coming of the Lord. The *Our Father* is an integral part of the Liturgy of the Hours."
