The school also participates in the Corporate Tax Scholarship which pays tuition for families who show a financial need and the McKay Scholarship Program which provides tuition for students who are on an IEP to attend a private school. In addition to an excellent academic program, our students also receive classes in Spanish, Art, Music and Technology. We offer band, choir, sports and drama.
