RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION FOR 2009-2010 will be held **THIS WEEKEND** and next, **August 22-23**. Registration for **Religious Education classes, Youth Group**, and the **Sacraments of First Communion** and **Confirmation** will be held after all Masses. Early registration can be done in the parish office during regular hours. Forms will also be made available on the parish website. (www.olv.ptdiocese.org) Classroom space in certain grades is limited, so please sign up early. Classes will begin the first Wednesday in September on the 2nd. Registration fees are: \$15 for Youth Group, \$15 for Sacramental preparation, and \$20 per child in grades 1-8 with a \$60 maximum fee per family. **To facilitate our teachers' planning, all children must be preregistered in order to attend the first night of class.** We are looking forward to another faith-filled year with the children of our Parish!
