Registration for **Religious Education classes, Youth Group,** and the **Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation** will be held after all Masses. (www.olv.ptdiocese.org) Classroom space in certain grades is limited, so please sign up early. Classes will begin the first Wednesday in September on the 2nd. Registration fees are: \$15 for Youth Group, \$15 for Sacramental preparation, and \$20 per child in grades 1-8 with a \$60 maximum fee per family. **To facilitate our teachers' planning, all children must be preregistered in order to attend the first night of class.** We are looking forward to another faith-filled year with the children of our Parish!
