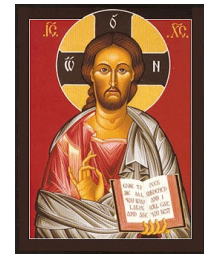

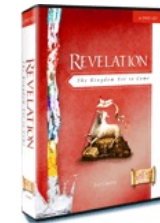

Spiritual Adoption Update Month 2: "I'm dancing!"

The developing baby is now called a "fetus," a Latin word meaning "little one." She is making rapid progress developing all her external and internal organs, and by 8 weeks all her body systems are present. Brain waves can also now be recorded. During this second month of life baby teeth begin to form, and fingers and toes are developing. Her ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be clearly seen, and her skeleton changes from cartilage to bone. The central nervous system is functioning and her forty muscle sets are practicing their first exercises.
