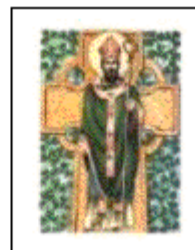

Penance services during lent. I was not able to arrange for priests for a communal Penance service this Lent at Holy Rosary. There are several opportunities for communal penance services: at St Joseph in Dayton on Tuesday, March 21, 6:30 pm; Holy Family Clarkston on Monday, March 27, at 7:00 pm; St James in Lewiston on Tuesday, March 28th, at 7:00 pm; Lourdes in Lewiston on Wednesday, March 29th, at 7:00 pm and at St Stan's on Thursday, March 30th, at 7:00pm.

Celebration of the Sacrament of Penance is also available at Holy Rosary every Saturday between 8:00 and 8:45 am before the Saturday morning Mass and on Wednesday April 5th (before Bible Study) and Thursday April 6th (before the Knights of Columbus meeting) both at 6:00 pm. and 10:30 Sunday (before Mass) at St Joseph and at St Mark on Tuesday evening March 28th and April 4th at 5:00 pm (before the Tuesday evening Mass).

By popular request: Ladies' Lenten Lead-in Luscious Lasserole
4 chicken breasts, cooked and cubed
3 cups cooked rice
1 package chopped frozen broccoli
4 chopped green onions
1 can water chestnuts (chopped)
1 can cream of chicken soup (can use two if you think it's needed)
1 cup mayonnaise
1 teaspoon curry powder
3-4 cups sharp grated cheese
Combine soup, mayo, 2 cups grated cheese and curry powder in large bowl. Add chicken, rice, broccoli, green onions and water chestnuts. Mix all and season with salt and pepper to taste. Spread in 9 X 13 pan. Bake at 350 for about 30 minutes. Add remaining 1-2 cups cheese and cover with French fried onion rings and bake another 5-10 minutes (till cheese has melted and onion rings and crispy.) Enjoy.
