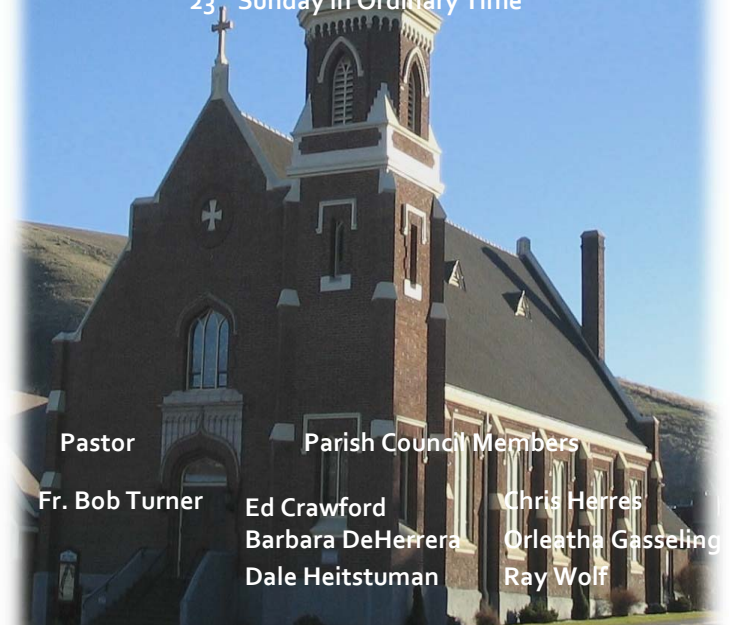

**Report on Fund Raising**

A parishioner asked if grain could be donated to the parish for the settlement, church roof, and cemetery endowment. Yes, wheat can be donated at the Pomeroy Grain Growers by designating the grain for Holy Rosary Catholic Church. Please also write on your pledge card the details of the donation and we will be able to follow up.

The deadline for the parish bankruptcy assessment payment is September 15th. By this date the parish must transfer \$62,000 to the bankruptcy account.

Parish Council will meet on Thursday September 20th.

Nigro as he leads retreatants through the St. Ignatius Spiritual Exercises, written more than 450 years ago. St. Ignatius believed that he received these Spiritual Exercises as a gift from God not only to enrich his own Christian life, but to share with others. The gift was a 'method', a way to seek and find God in all things and to gain the freedom to let God's will be done on earth. This way of praying allowed St. Ignatius to discover the voice of God within his own heart. The retreatants will learn to follow the 'methods' of prayer that are outlined in the Spiritual Exercises and will receive the understanding of how to follow Jesus and seek God's will in any circumstance. The Eight Day St. Ignatian Retreat includes lodging, meals and spiritual direction each day. Cost is \$520 per person.
