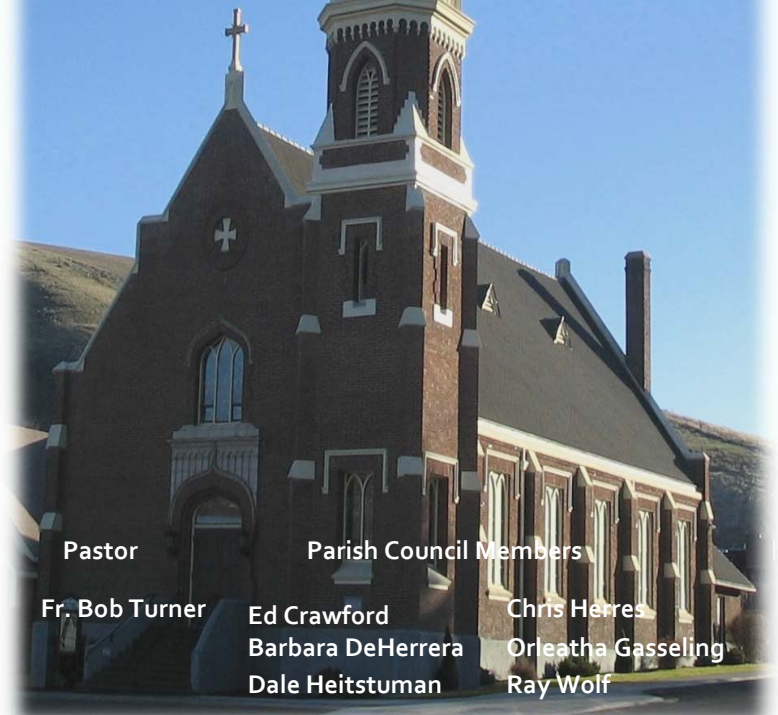

Please also write on your pledge card the details of the donation and we will be able to follow up.

The deadline for the parish bankruptcy assessment payment is September 15th. By this date the parish must transfer \$62,000 to the bankruptcy account.
