The City Council will soon make a decision about the cost for water at the cemetery. About the year 2000, the City Council changed the practice of providing the Catholic Cemetery with water without charge. The Cemetery began to be charged both a basic fee and an additional charge for use over the basic allotment for a residence. The parish tried to obtain a permit for a well to avoid this substantial increase parish cost for cemetery maintenance (from zero cost to approximately \$1,500 to \$2,000 per year). No permits have been granted for wells that are not part of a residential use so the alternative of a well has not been possible. The new charge also prompted the parish to spend \$18,000 to install a sprinkler system to conserve water.

The charge for water at the cemetery followed the charges for a residence not irrigation of acreage. The city does give free water to other properties such as the city cemetery, golf course, parks, etc. When it changed its practice in regard to the Catholic cemetery, this change singled out the cemetery for unequal treatment. This past year, the parish asked the City to reconsider its decision for its charges for water for the cemetery and the Council agreed to stop charges for overage for one season, charge only for basic service and gather the statistics of water use at the cemetery. The parish requests that the City treat the Catholic Cemetery equally with other acreage dedicated to the public good and no longer treat the cemetery as residential property.
