Pray the Sign of the Cross-

Some things become so familiar that we take them for granted. A good practice would be to stop and think about what we're doing when we make the Sign of the Cross. The cross is the center of Christianity; it signifies the deepest surrender to God's will. As we recall at the Baptismal ceremony, "We die with Christ to rise again in Him."

When I make the Sign of the Cross, I affirm my own surrender to God's will. While tracing the sign over my body, I pray that I will live as a member of God's Kingdom.
