Steele County Food Shelf March Food Share Campaign

March is the time of the year to help by donating to the local food shelf. A 2006 study funded by America's Second Harvest found that some 35 million people living in the United States struggle each year to get enough to eat. Last year in Steele County, 1,143 individuals were registered. Over the year 16,825 packages of food, filled with one week worth of food was delivered to the families. At the end of the year 566,224 pounds of food was purchased and/or donated. Volunteers helped to stock and give away food to people who were not able to provide for all their basic need.
