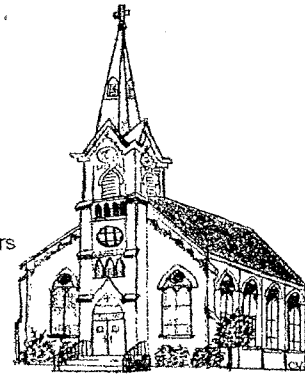

SICK CALLS - Persons unable to attend Mass, please contact the rectory for Holy Communion.

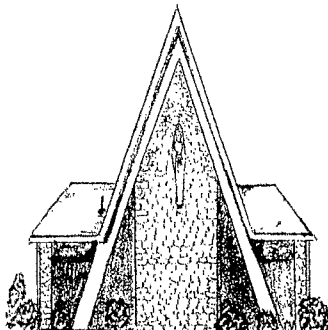
