**Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion**  
**March 16, 2008**

A Message



Dear parishioners,

With shouts of “*Hosanna!*” and “*Crucify Him!*” we express that while sometimes we proclaim our faith, we often do not follow through with our good intentions to truly follow Jesus Christ in all we say and do. May our participation in today’s Eucharist strengthen us in holiness. Together we journey through the holiest week of the year! Your participation is encouraged at our special liturgies.

**Morning Prayer.** Except for the Mass of the Lord’s Supper, the Eucharist is not celebrated during the Sacred Triduum, until the great Easter Vigil. Instead, we celebrate the Church’s “Liturgy of the Hours” – Morning Prayer – at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Friday and Saturday in the Church. Easy-to-follow worship aids will be provided. Please come join us!

**Holy Thursday.** The Mass of the Lord’s Supper begins at 8 p.m. This celebration commemorates the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood. During this Mass, the priest washes the feet of 12 people – symbolizing in ritual that the priest, shepherd of the community, gives an example of humble service in imitation of Jesus Christ. This Mass ends with a Eucharistic procession to the place of repossession – our rectory chapel. Silent adoration takes place until we offer Night Prayer at 11 p.m.

**Good Friday.** The five churches of Allendale join together in prayer on this day, as we move in a Stations of the Cross procession through town. What a powerful witness to the Christian unity we strive for – what an opportunity for the public witness of our faith! We begin at noon here at Guardian Angel Church. The principal liturgy of the day is our celebration of the Passion of Our Lord, with Veneration of the Cross and distribution of Holy Communion, which takes place at 8 p.m.

**Holy Saturday.** We would be most grateful for help in decorating our parish church this morning! Many people continue the Good Friday fasting and abstinence through this day as well. You may bring your family’s “Easter Food” to the church at noon for a blessing.

**Easter Vigil.** (*There are no 4:30 Confessions or 5:30 Mass*) This liturgy must begin after sundown, so we start at 8 p.m. While we do not have any adults preparing for Christian initiation this year, the liturgy, which first celebrates the Lord’s Resurrection, is a powerful reminder of our baptism and of God’s saving grace.

**Easter Sunday.** Alleluia! Alleluia! He is Risen! We welcome the many visiting family and friends who find a home in our parish on this day. Our special schedule for Mass today is 7:30 a.m., 10 a.m., and 12 noon. The 11:30 a.m. Mass resumes next week.

“Morning after morning he opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting.”

– Isaiah 50:4-7

This past weekend five of our teens went on the Archdiocesan Crossroads retreat: Stephen Brown, Cody Cavagrotti, Deanna Colarusso, Julius Lizardo, Tory Sandberg. It was an amazing experience! God called them to the retreat, but had they not been willing to hear His voice, or be encouraged by their parents to respond to that voice, we would have never had that life changing experience.

Do we incline our hearts and our ears to God’s call? The quote above from today’s first reading describes someone, who not only anticipates from the very beginning of the day an experience with God, but also is willing to follow that call in humility. The call of a Catholic Christian especially in this transition of Lent to Easter is to surrender to the saving power of God. It is not by our strength that we are saved; it is by God’s call and our response to surrender to that call.

This past Monday, five teens: Chris Puig, Brendon Bigly, Brian Convit, Chris Morriss, and Ralph Lenzi met with Matt Bigley, Bill Konvit, and Belinda Morriss to discuss plans for our mission trip. The teens, hearing the call have responded. In July we will spend a week (20-26) in Chicago, rebuilding areas of the community that really need it. We will humbly serve the Body of Christ as His hands and feet.

Something to Think About: God’s call is not always in a thunderous voice. Often times it is in the invitation of another, an invitation where we find ourselves debating, “I don’t really want to do this, but I probably should,” or “I don’t really want to go, but I probably should.” Maybe it is time to clear our schedule and respond to God’s call.
