

## Parish Emergency Food Supplies

June 1<sup>st</sup> is the start of Hurricane Season. As in recent past years, and in support of the Parish's Disaster Response Plan, we will be collecting "Emergency Food Supplies" throughout the month of June to assist in emergency relief for those parishioners who may be in need if a hurricane or other natural disaster occurs this season. The schedule for this effort (which includes the suggested emergency support items) is as follows:

- **June 6 – June 7:** Bottled Water (cases or gallons); Paper Towels; Large Plastic Bags
- **June 13 – June 14:** Shelf packaged Juice and Powdered Milk; Prepared Foods (canned) – meats, tuna, peanut butter, vegetables, etc.
- **June 20 – June 21:** Dried and packaged Fruits and Nuts; Snacks – Crackers, Cookies, Chips, Breakfast Bars (cereal)
- **June 27 – June 28:** Baby Food; Diapers (all sizes), Diaper Wipes; Paper Plates, Napkins, Plastic Cutlery, Cups, etc.

Drop-off will be on the dates provided above at the Parish Meeting House at the following times:

- **Saturdays: 3:00 – 4:00 pm**
- **Sundays: 9:00 – 1200 am**

**(Note: If you need to drop off your items early, please leave them on the front porch area of the Parish Meeting House...they will be subsequently taken care of and stored.)**

Additional information on Emergency Disaster Planning, to help support parishioners, will be provided in upcoming church bulletins and documents.
