I was able to talk with Father Dennis about the Holy Week Schedule. We will do what we did last year. Please note especially the Responsorial Psalm at the Easter Vigil. Where singing is indicated, the Cantor will do it or lead it. Where it is indicated that the Psalm or Refrain is to be recited, the reader of the preceding passage will stay at ambo and lead the recitation.

For example: After the first reading both the psalm and refrain will be sung (Cantor). After the second reading, the reader will stay at the ambo and recite the Psalm. The Cantor will lead the congregation in singing the refrain. After the third reading, the reader will remain at the ambo and lead the recitation of the Psalm and Refrain. This cycle repeats for the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th readings/responsorial psalms and the epistle.

1. First Reader carries book in entrance procession if there is no deacon.
2. Second Reader makes announcements before mass and if there is no deacon, returns to ambo for prayers of the faithful.
3. Please check with Dennis or Frank to determine if there is to be children's liturgy on Sunday. Make this announcement before the first reading.
4. Note that the last Sunday of the month 0800 AM Mass involves the Knights of Columbus Corporate Mass. I have attempted to schedule only Knights for this mass.
5. Please arrive 10 to 15 minutes before mass and initial your name on the schedule. When not scheduled, check to see if everyone scheduled has shown up. If someone appears to be a no-show, please let an usher know that you are able to cover the absence.
6. As a practical matter always come to mass dressed as though you were going to be on the altar so that you can substitute if someone does not make it. **If you wear an outdoors top coat, please remove it before going up to the ambo.**
