2 — Brother Knights, you should be aware that 52 Brother Knights volunteered to do Bingo and Kitchen duties prior to February, 2006. Today that number is 28 struggling Brothers. Eleven (11) are over 70 years old, and the oldest is 86. The first lesson of the Knights of Columbus is CHARITY. It seems as though this lesson has been forgotten. More volunteers will improve our image with our customers.

Brother Knights.

Over the past several months we, as a Council, have been struggling with the Bingo program. Its role as our primary revenue producer (which goes to support our charity work and Hall operating expenses) is in serious jeopardy. Despite several re-writes of the Bingo program, adding and changing games and prize money, the program remains in jeopardy.

What has become the most troubling issue is the lack of your support and participation. We need, every Saturday night, at least 12 people for bingo and the snack bar. We have, at best, about 6-7 people *some* Saturdays, including the snack bar. Our team leaders have been working every Saturday to make up for those of you, scheduled on teams, who have not been showing up for various reasons.

Brothers, we need about \$1,400.00 a month to operate the Knight's Hall. Without bingo, we do not have enough to keep our bills paid each month. Now, if that doesn't give you cause for concern, please reexamine your feelings about our Council. So few Knights are shouldering the burden of keeping the Council going.

We ask only that if you are scheduled to work Bingo, be sure you are there. If you are not presently serving on a team, I need you to volunteer. If I had the ability to "draft" you, I'd be drafting 12-14 people *right now!* This is not a whim or desire, it is a *necessity*.

We have just re-written the bingo program as of today, 8/22/07. It will shorten the program, increase pay-outs per game, yet save us some money and increase our revenues, hopefully. We will be done with bingo, beginning the first Saturday of September, by 9:30pm. The key to this is your help. If we don't get some more of you to help out, the program is in serious doubt. Then, we have to suddenly try to cover our building expenses without a steady income source. Forget about charity, there won't be any.

The only charity I ask of you is about 6 hours of your time once a month for bingo.

Help us on a bingo team or a kitchen team. Call me, John Marchal, Jerry Goebel, Rob Baker or Bob Haring. We will get you assigned and we can continue to do our work.

I don't believe you will find a reference in the Holy Scriptures about what our return (margin of profit) should be when we are volunteering for charity. Charity is giving from the heart with no pre-conception of return. Does your Christian charity have a minimum profit margin before you will begin to donate your time?
