Steve Rhodes called the meeting to order.

Father Dennis led the meeting with a prayer.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved as posted.

The council voted Steve Rhodes as Chairman, Bill Michie as Vice Chairman and Joel Dunham as Secretary.

The agenda was amended to include discussion of the Parish picture directory by Father Dennis.

**Ministry Reports:**

Liturgical – Deacon Chris

Deacon Chris addressed the need for additional hymnals. Father suggested having the music ministry request the funds from the finance committee.

Youth – Candice Rhodes and Joel Delabruere

Candice stated the teens are raising money for relay for life. They have already raised \$2300, their goal is \$4000. They are planning a spaghetti lunch and a “kiss the pig” fund raiser after 10:30 mass.

Joel stated Antioch weekend would be the weekend of the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 18<sup>th</sup> of February. February 10<sup>th</sup> will be the Winter Jam Christian concert and on the 24<sup>th</sup> of February will be the Reality Check Conference in Tallahassee.

Stewardship – Bill Michie

Bill discussed the Catholic Sharing Appeal (CSA). The first mailings have gone out and our parish will be sending out secondary letters to the parishioners shortly. Bill will be explaining CSA at each mass.

### Hospitality – Kim Fagan

The K of C Ladies Auxiliary and the funeral support ministry had nothing to report. Ladies society is getting ready for St Patrick's Day. Additionally, their bake sale was successful

### Finance Committee- Marvin Brossett

A spreadsheet will be handed out at mass twice a year listing parish finances.

The first reconciliation took place the previous weekend. They had a middle school conference which was successful; it brought more kids back to "Edge". For the first communion classes they are trying to get more parents involved in order to get the course completed.
