During this past year Karen has received Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapy. The first of July she was given a test and it had been determined that she had reached her MMI, or Maximum Medical Improvement. She was released by the doctors and only needs to make an annual visit.

Karen has decided to try her hand at ranching. She is living in North Dakota with a friend on a 100 year old ranch and learning things we never think about here in the city.

We will always thank God and all of you for the gift of having Karen still with us.
