Ash Wednesday—February 6:

Join us for **Mass at 9 am or 7 pm**. Receive the cross of ashes that reminds us to “*turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel*”. Make a personal commitment to repent of your failings, and to grow spiritually during the Lenten season.

Weekend Liturgies:

We continue with our regular weekend Mass Schedule: Sat. 5:00 pm; Sun. At 8:00, **9:20**, & 11:00 am. (*EXCEPT-NOTE Sunday Mass time changes for Palm Sunday & Easter!*)

RCIA Rites:
