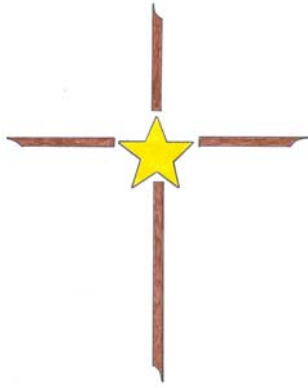

What is the Women's Cornerstone Retreat?

The retreat is a 26-hour spiritual renewal that is planned and conducted by women who have previously participated in the retreat. The retreat will give you time to pray, reflect, and listen to God through the lives and experiences of these women. It will also give you an opportunity to meet and join with other women in building a revitalized and deeper relationship with God. The retreat has been offered annually at St. Bernard's since 1988.

What is the Goal of Cornerstone?

The goal of Cornerstone is to get a better sense of who you are as a woman of faith so that you return to your everyday life spiritually refreshed.

When is Cornerstone?

Cornerstone XXI begins on Friday, November 13th at 6:30pm with light refreshments and ends with a special Saturday evening Mass that begins at 7:00pm. Your family is encouraged to share in this mass with you.

Where is Cornerstone held?

The overnight retreat is held entirely on the grounds of St. Bernard Church. Sleeping accommodations are on the lower level of the church. Air mattresses are provided for all retreatants. We encourage participants to spend the night to share in the full retreat experience, but special accommodations can be made, if needed.

What is the cost?

There is a \$35 registration fee. All meals are included. Space is limited and reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. So we urge you to make your reservation as soon as possible. Scholarships are available if needed. Registrations should be submitted by November 5, 2009 to ensure placement.
